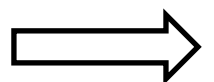

more + some + all	with→ countable nouns (plural) / uncountable nouns / positive sentences
any	with→ countable nouns (plural) / uncountable / negative sentences / questions

too many	with countable nouns (plural)
too much	with uncountable nouns

- 6- Have you got (**much – any**) ideas about things to do?
- 7- Do you know (**how much – how many**) people live in the city?

Uncountable nouns

* too + adjective → to describe nouns

* not + adjective + enough → to describe nouns

* not + enough + noun

14- I can't drive a car yet. I'm not (**old enough – too old**) .

15- I prefer to live in a big city. This town is (**small enough – too small**) .

16- These buildings are (**dark enough – too dark**) .

the	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * with singular and plural * the second time you mention something * before the names of rivers , oceans , seas and mountains * before superlative adjectives (the best , the most beautiful , the biggest * the first , the second , the seventeenth * when there's only one of something (the sun , the moon , the Arab World, the president , the world , the west , the north
Zero article (X)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * before the names of (cities , villages , countries , continents , ... * with means of transport (by ship , by plane , by bus , by car * when making generalizations → countable → uncountable
